


Híroshí Fujímoto RECOGNITION AWARD

This award is handed out each year at the Men's Region 1 Championships. The recipient of the award is a person in the Region who has given of himself/herself above and beyond other members of Region 1. This award is in recognition of selflessness of the recipient in either the prior year, or in a cumulative basis throughout many years. This award is the most prestigious award given to a member of our Region 1 Men's Gymnastics community. It reflects the dedication of that years' recipient to the development, administration, vision and/or quality of men's gymnastics in Region 1 in the spirit of Hiroshi Fujimoto's contribution to our Region.

Roger is most known as the Chairman for Region 1. As one of the most successful Regional Chairman, under Roger, Region 1 won more Regional Team Championships than any other Region (including a sweep of all 3 teams in 2009)! Prior to serving as the Region 1 Chairman for the 12 years (doing an incredible job), Roger served as the Nevada State Chairman for 13 years. Together, with his wife Debbie, they started and directed the Select Team Camp, and in the summer of 2007 traveled over 20 Region 1 gymnasts to Japan!!

Roger Baldwin has been a Co-Meet Director for a number of large events including the 2011 & 2014 JO Nationals in Long Beach as well as the 2007, 2008, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2015, & 2017 Regional's. He has also volunteered his time at the 1995, 1999, 2002, & 2005 Regionals and at the 2002, 2004, & 2007 JO Nationals, as well as the 2003 World Championships!

Roger and Debbie owned High Sierra Gymnastics for 10 years and continue to work there under the current owner. Roger has recently retired as the Region 1 Chairman but continues to coach

Most notably, in 2009 Roger received the Frank Cumiskey Award (the highest award in Men's Gymnastics)!
