

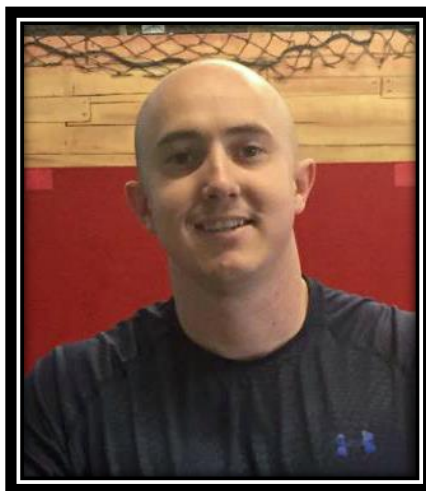

Adam began gymnastics at the spry age of three when his mother decided to enroll him in his first gymnastics class and he never looked back. Adam spent his formative gymnastics career under the tutelage of Steve Butcher who instilled work ethic, determination, positivity and a growth mind set. Adam's love of the of the sport never wavered, transitioning from a nearly 15-year competitive career right into competitive team coaching.

Adam began his competitive coaching career more than two decades ago at SCEGA gymnastics in Temecula, CA. During his time there he coached athletes to more than 100 state, regional and national titles as well as more than a dozen athletes to the U.S. Future Star and Junior National Teams.

In 2019, Adam fulfilled his dream of becoming a gymnastics club owner when he started Agility Kids in Temecula, CA. Adam's recent athletes include the 2023 Xfinity US National Champion and four **Team USA International Competitions** to include **5 Gold Medals, 4 Silver Medals & 2 bronze medals!**

Adam has been a part of the SCMGA (SoCal) board of directors and the Region 1 Board for more than 15 years. In 2016 Adam was appointed to the Region 1 Chairman position (for 6 years). Adam is currently serving as the Vice Chairman for the Region 1 Board. During his tenure as chairman, Adam organized 2 International Train Aways for more than 40 Region 1 athletes combined to Tatabanya, Hungary in 2017 and 2019! Adam is currently on the USAG Jr National Coaching Staff (2014-2020 & 2023-Present). He has been a nationally rated judge for 18 years and is a frequent presenter at the USA National Congress & National Coaches Workshop.
